Guidelines for Contributors

1. All manuscripts should be submitted to zfe@posteo.de
 2. The editors welcome original articles of up to 8.000 words, reviews of up to 1.000 words, 'shortcuts' submissions of 1.600–1.800 words, in German or in English. The submitted articles should not be under consideration elsewhere.
 3. Articles should be formatted as 1½ space with a 3 cm margin on all sides. Submissions should be sent as an e-mail attachment in MS Word format. Please avoid underlining as far as possible. Foreign words should be italicized. Articles must be accompanied by an abstract of not more than 200 words and 4–5 keywords.
 4. References within the text should be cited in the following form: (Robbins 2004: 132). Footnotes should be kept to a minimum and must be numbered consecutively throughout the text. Any figure captions should be listed on a separate sheet. On a further sheet complete references to all works cited must be provided, arranged in alphabetical and calendrical order, as in the following examples:
 - Robbins, Joel 2004: *Becoming Sinners: Christianity and Moral Torment in a Papua New Guinea Society*. Berkeley, Los Angeles, London: University of California Press.
 - Nguyen, Minh T.N. 2014: Fictitious Kinship: Intimacy, Relatedness and Boundaries in the Life of Hanoi's Migrant Domestic Workers. *Cambridge Journal of Anthropology* 32 (2): 81–96.
 - Olukoshi, Adebayo; Nyamnjoh, Francis 2011: The Postcolonial Turn: An Introduction. In: R. Devisch and F. B. Nyamnjoh (eds.), *The Postcolonial Turn: Re-Imagining Anthropology and Africa*. Bamenda: Langaa RPCIG, pp. 1–28.
 - Grimme, Gesa 2020: Das eigene Berufsfeld untersuchen: Provenienzforschung ethnographisch betrachten. *Fieldwork Meets Crisis*. <https://boasblogs.org/fieldworkmeetscrisis/das-eigene-berufsfeld-untersuchen/> (accessed April 24, 2021).
 - Tables, maps and illustrations should be on separate pages, numbered and with headings. Indicate in the text where they should appear.
 5. All articles will be submitted to referees by the editors. Responsibility for opinions published remains with the authors.
 6. When articles have been accepted in their final form, they should be submitted for publication as an e-mail attachment. Please keep formatting and the use of tabs and spaces to a minimum. Authors will receive proofs for correction, which must be returned within ten days of receipt to the publisher. For personal use, authors will receive a free electronic offprint in PDF-format.
- Subsequently, unless the author is willing to bear the additional expenses, we will be unable to pay regard to later text alterations deviating from the manuscript.
